### Penderyn Madeira Finish 46% (D)

Wales £3.30

Sweet, medium body. Herbal, vanilla, sweetness, resin, sultanas, toast. Over-ripe grape. Thick and sweet, spices, green, biscuity. Custard. Finish: Fresh, crisp, spices and stem ginger.

### Singleton of Dufftown 12 year old 40% (E)

Speyside £3.30

Orange zest spiciness perks up a malty core of nuts, oak and toffee, hints of cut grass. Finish: Oaky, rich with good length, some fruit lingers.

### Talisker 10 year old 40% (D)

Islands £3.30

Full bodied with huge plumes of smoke and volcanic, peppery peat. Intense. Finish: Long finish, barley, malt.

### Laphroaig 10 year old 40% (G)

Islay £3.50

The oak is big, and muscles its way into the fore as you hold this whisky over your tongue. An upsurge of spices develop cardamom/black pepper/chilli. Finish is big and drying, as the savoury, tarry notes build up with an iodine complexity.

### Oban 14 year old 40% (D)

Highlands £3.50

Notes of citrus with smooth sweetness. The smoke wafts with notes of seaweed. The oak is quite rich with grist and cereal and malt. The finish is of good length with fruit and dry oak.

### Lagavulin 16 year old 43% (G)

Islay £4.00

Very thick and rich. A massive mouthful of malt and sherry with good fruity sweetness, but also a wonderful sweetness. Big, powerful peat and oak. Finish: Long, spicy finish, figs, dates, peat smoke, vanilla.

### Monte Grande Blanco

Spain £3.10 £3.95 £5.25 £15.50

This lovely melon scented wine offers a clean fresh nose produced with the addition of Sauvignon Blanc to the blend. The palate is soft and rounded and develops a lovely subtle texture that is both clean and inviting. A great partner to fish, white meats and salads or simply to enjoy by the glass with friends.

### Moulin de Gassac Chardonnay

France £3.55 £4.25 £5.85 £16.95

Classic soft ripe Chardonnay from the south of France. Creamy note gives way to a full yet well balanced palate. Delicious, great food partner for elegant dishes.

### Frederico Collezione Pinot Grigio

Italy £3.85 £4.50 £6.25 £17.95

This is a fine and elegant style of Pinot Grigio, with a nose of soft citrus fruits and intense minerality. This quality is echoed on the palate with a complex mouth feel of bright apple and pear flavours. Beautifully balanced with a midweight mouth feel, this refined wine is the perfect partner to classic caesar salads and fresh fish, king prawns and chicken dishes.

### Casas Del Toqui Sauvignon Blanc Reserva

Chile £3.95 £4.95 £6.95 £18.95

An intense and ripe nose of gooseberry and asparagus dominate this wine. The palate is refreshing with notes of green grass and mineral. A wonderfully polished Sauvignon Blanc, complex and refined. A great partner to goats cheese, zesty salads and chicken.

### 1659 Chenin Blanc

South Africa £18.75

An elegant nose laden with pear, apple and a touch of orange peel precedes a lovely clean and crisp palate, offering more pear and tropical guava notes. Try with a spicy Thai or herbaceous salad.

### Suikerbossie Sauvignon Blanc

South Africa £18.95

Herbaceous and grassy, this Sauvignon is closer to the Loire than Marlborough in style. Picked early, it exhibits peas, bell pepper and lemon citrus notes on the nose. The palate follows with more grassy notes and lemon acidity to leave a crisp finish.

### Albarino Pazo Torrado

Spain £19.95

A beautiful example of this luscious varietal offering a heady mix of watermelon and tangerine notes. The body is lively and mouthwatering and is an ideal wine to share with friends or to accompany seafood, chicken or salads.

### Falanghina Cantina De Falco

Italy £21.50

This top quality Pinot Grigio from one of Italy's superstar producers shows what this grape can really do. Full and ripe, this wine is rich in the mouth and is a perfect partner for white meats with sauces, salmon and rich fish dishes.

The juniper is predominantly in the nose, but well balanced with fresh coriander notes. Fresh citrus and spice backdrop on the palate.

### Bombay Sapphire 40%

England

Try with: Tonic & Fresh Lime

A touch of juniper, ripe citrus and hints of spice in the fragrance. Piney juniper, faint lavender and mixed peppery spice finish.

### Hayman's Old Tom 40%

England

Try with: Tonic & Fresh Lime

Perfectly balanced traditional lightly-sweetened gin style. Candied ginger, orange peel and lemon zest, with accents of violet and tangy juniper.

### Hunters 43.3%

Candied lime zest, piney juniper and musky, nutty, balsawood-like angelica root with delicate floral aromas. Faint cinnamon spice.

Wonderfully rounded palate is incredibly silky considering its heady alcoholic strength. Juniper is integrated with freshly squeezed lemon, orange and zesty pink grapefruit while white pepper and coriander spice add depth.

Clean with faint black pepper and charcoal aroma, to taste it has subtle minerality with pepper and a slight peppermint freshness.

### Chase 40%

England

A wholesome buttery scent on the nose, with a full bodied and creamy texture. Mashed potato and butter, leading to a slightly smoked almond finish, with a hint of black pepper.

### Chase Marmalade 40%

England

£3.50

Clear with a golden hue. Strong orange zest on the nose, with a naturally rich bittersweet flavour and a warm velvety mouth feel.

### Chase Rhubarb 40%

England

£3.50

A light, fresh scent of rhubarb aromas dance on the nose and palate, with a slight sweetness coming through as it nears the end.

## RUM

### Bacardí Carta Blanca 37.5%

Puerto Rico

Tropical fruits and almonds on the nose followed by a little spice, vanilla dominates the palate. A smooth offering, developing into a dry finish with a hint of spice.

### Kraken Black Spiced Rum 40%

Trinidad

Slightly sweet, cola-like vanillered spicy palate with espresso coffee, creamy caramel, cinnamon, cloves and gingerbread.

### Gosling's Black Seal Rum 40%

Bermuda

Dark muscovado sugar/treacle and spicy cinnamon with zesty orange and burnt fruit cake. Mix with ginger beer & lime for a Dark 'n' Stormy.

### El Dorado 12 Year Old 40%

Slightly sweet, yet balanced with mocha coffee, dark chocolate, sherry trifle, cooked apples and cinnamon spice. Try this after dinner or instead of a malt whisky.

Rich, chewy, rounded and smooth, with complex citrus, cinnamon and cocoa. Toffee, caramel, chocolate and spice notes abound.

Rich, chewy, rounded and smooth, with complex citrus, cinnamon and cocoa. Toffee, caramel, chocolate and spice notes abound.

### Remy Martin VSOP 40%

France

Cooked and chewy palate with nutty, cracked black peppery oak, bitter-sweetness with vanilla, faint maple syrup and liquorice.

Soft hints of vanilla on the nose with a light, smooth aroma boding well for the long offering on the palate. Smoother offer of grain and honey at the end.

### Monkey Shoulder 40%

Scotland

Very malty, creamy delivery which offers up a palate redolent of berry fruit, juicy toasted barley, cloves and butterscotch. A hint of manuka honey, hot-buttered-toast and dried apricot develop. Finish: Medium length, with clove-studded oranges, creamy vanilla and peppermint on the tail.

# Regions

## Speyside

Over half of Scotland's malt whisky distilleries can be found within this one region. Undoubtedly the heart of single malt whisky distilling in Scotland.

It's classic flavours of honey, vanilla and fresh fruits combine to create whiskies that are both sophisticated and elegant. With age they evolve to deliver dried fruit and sweet spice flavours.

## Highlands

One of the most scenic regions in Scotland. Geographically the largest of the whisky-producing regions. It covers some major areas and a variety of warm, rounded single malt whiskies: The West Coast with its maritime influence on malts such as Oban; the Central Highlands, including the heather and honey from one of Scotland's highest distilleries, Dalwhinnie.

## Lowlands

The terrain of the Lowlands is characterised by rolling fields which are ideally suited to growing grain for whisky. Tend to be lighter in both colour and body, than those of the Highlands. With little or no peat used in the drying of the malt, the whiskies distilled here are generally fresh and light, fragrant and floral with cereal flavourings.

## Island

Sitting amongst the Inner Hebridean Scottish Isles, are the malt whisky producing islands of Islay and Skye. The rugged island landscapes generally produce single malt whiskies with strong peaty aromas.

The Islands malts are unmistakably powerful, bursting with flavour, from the recognised smokiness apparent in almost all offerings,

Speyside

£3.00

Rich, honey, stone fruits, chestnuts, walnuts, almonds. Berries. Finish: Smoky, good length, delicate peppery spice.

### Dalwhinnie 15 year old 43% (B)

Highlands

£3.00

Malty. Walnuts steeped in manuka honey with vanilla sponge. Gentle smoke weaves its way through the cereal with a touch of spice.

### Glenfiddich 12 year old 40% (B)

Speyside

£3.00

Grain. Slightly floral, mineralic. Spirity, orchard fruit, malty, honey. Citrus develops. Light, floral, spices. Very smooth. Sweet, touch of oak and general fruit, oily.

### Glenkinchie 12 year old 43% (A)

Lowlands

£3.00

Barley, freshly cut grass and cream-of-soda vanilla with herbal teak wood, walnut shells, toasted coconut and wisps of smoke. Light and malty, spicy crème anglaise with underlying dry smoky salty oak.

### Glenmorangie 10 year old 40% (B)

Highlands

£3.00

Fresh and balanced, vanilla. Boiled sweets, very creamy, tiramisu, toffee. Finish: Quite long, gentle, malty and very fruity.

### Highland Park 12 year old 40% (E)

Islands

£3.00

Notes of granary toast and green tea with jasmine. A touch of sweetness. The finish is quite long with peppered spicy and wood shavings

### Isle of Jura 10 year old 40% (C)

Islands

£3.00

The palate is thick and full with more cereal, this time a barley fudge sweetness creeps in with creamy smoothness and a touch of aniseed. The finish is long with peppery winter spice.

### The Glenlivet 12 year old 40% (D)

Speyside

£3.00

Apple cores, fresh and fruity trifle and creamy citrus. Finish: Long and delicious, almonds and apple.

### Balvenie Doublewood 12 year old 40% (E)

Speyside

£3.30

Initially burst of rich sherry and red apple, quickly dried with lightly spiced and smoky oak, beautifully balanced with stewed fruit and ginger bread.
