 Daffodil Walks

Why not combine your visit with a delicious Pub Lunch at our lovely local "The Plough" at Whitegate. They also offer parking and maps for those who wish to extend their walk www.ploughwhitegate.com

Turn left out of the Plough car park and walk alongside the row of semi-detached dwellings and near the end of the lane take a left between the gap in the houses. Continue along the edge of the field and continue ahead and through two kissing gates. Descend to a footbridge and continue up the field opposite. Side-step (right) through a gate in the hedge and continue upwards with the hedge on your left before reaching the road at Foxwist Green. Turn right and continue to the end of the road before bearing left and onto the dwelling called Foxdell. Walk up the side of the dwelling to the caravan park, where you can report to the log cabin before undertaking the Daffodil walk (1km) (Refreshment tent also available). On completing the walk, return back to the Plough the way you came.

Option B – The Plough & Foxwist Green Circular. (3.3km)

Turn left out of the Plough car, walk to the bottom of the lane and take the path to the left of Haresclough and descend Gooseberry Hollow. Cross the footbridge and turn left and as the track turns up to the right, go left & through the kissing gate. Pass through the woodland and through the gate & into the field. Cross the field to the left of the timber bungalow and over the stile. Walk along the narrow path alongside Sixes Pool and keep straight ahead to cross a footbridge.

After turning left at the end of the path (ignore the first path to the left) Turn right over the second footbridge and walk upwards to reach a gate. Go through the gate and Turn right and walk a short distance to the end of the road. Bear left and onto the dwelling called Foxdell, walk up the side of the dwelling to the caravan park, where you can report to the log cabin before undertaking the Daffodil walk (1km) (Refreshment tent also available).

Return to the Plough (option B).

After completing the Daffodil walk return to the road and continue along Foxwist Green passing the dwellings and after about a kilometre you will see a dirt track on your right. Go through the gap in the hedge opposite (to your left & next to the telegraph pole with the 20mph speed sign)

Walk along the path, through the kissing gate and then down and up to the next kissing gate which brings you to the main road. Turn left and then left again returning back to the Plough.
